**Right: We laugh at our God.**  
Left: We welcome Jesus.  
**Right: We will condemn him.**  
Left: We will turn from him.  
**Right: We will never follow him.**  
One: It was a long week, a long march from the high gate of Jerusalem to a forsaken place and a cross. Even longer from the praise of "Hosanna!" to the blasphemy of "Crucify!". A long march for humankind: from the high point of crowning God's chosen one, to the depths of having him executed. It was a long, long walk through the fickleness and whims of humanity and yet, God lives with us still.
