There will be no **Session** meeting in the month of February.

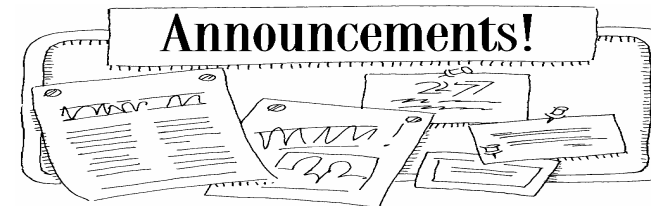
